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"72 Hour Lutheran" Checklist Proper identification Immunization records Flashlight/Batteries Battery operated and NOAA weather radio Fully charged cell phone A traditional (not cordless) telephone set Cash (with small bills) Extra keys Tools – keep a set with you during the storm Vehicle fuel tank (kept filled) Pet care items, including drinking water Stock up on non - perishable supplies One gallon of water per person per day Snack foods Cooking tools Non - electric can opener Fuel, oil for generators, chainsaws, etc. Paper plates and plastic utensils First - aid kit Medicines, Prescriptions Toiletries, hygiene items, moist wipes Weather & news apps downloaded to devices Tarps Bug repellant Duct tape
